Participation is open to those who live, work, attend school or therapies in the City of Chandler.

Please ensure your information remains current and accurate. Send an email to return.safe@chandleraz.gov to provide changes or withdraw from the program.

Registrants will be contacted via email every three years to inquire about continued participation in the program. If a response is not received in a reasonable amount of time, the record will be removed.

This information is only accessible to Chandler Police and Fire with proper security access. First responders may only be able to access this information when able to do so safely.

What Is Return Me Safe?



Chandler Police Department's Return Me Safe voluntary registry program is intended to support vulnerable individuals of all ages in our community who may have communication challenges or engage in wandering behavior. These communication and behavioral challenges may be due to an intellectual/developmental disability, a traumatic brain injury, Alzheimer's Disease and related disorders, or a medical condition.

By providing your local first responders with crucial information and a photograph prior to an actual emergency, valuable time spent collecting this information may be reduced, thus expediting and maximizing search efforts. This information also greatly assists police and fire personnel by helping to promote effective interactions.

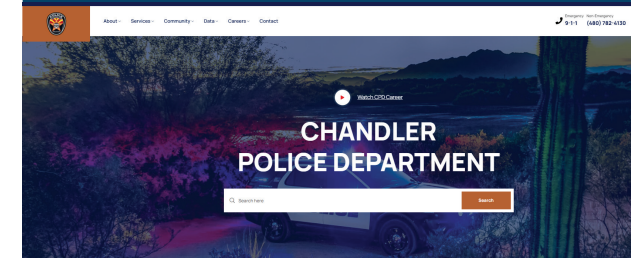
Why Do We Need Return Me Safe?



Individuals at-risk may be unable to identify themselves, or communicate with first responders in the event of a call for service, or an emergency. Via the confidential Return Me Safe program, first responders can access critical information about the immediate needs of an individual who is vulnerable.

This program is commonly used to help search for a missing person. However, there are times when police officers may locate a person prior to receiving a 911 call. This system rapidly provides valuable information, such as preferred communication method, suggestions for approach, behavioral considerations and previous wandering details.

How Do I Register Myself or Someone I Care For?



To register your loved one, access the Return Me Safe registration form under the "Services" drop down on our website at chandlerazpd.gov. Registration is free and easy. You can also scan the QR code below. You will be asked to upload a recent, high-quality photo of the person being registered.



Complete the online form for the person to be registered and submit for processing. If you are unable to complete the online submission form, you may fill out the PDF version, attach a photo, and seal your documents in an envelope and deliver them to any Chandler Police Station, Attn: Return Me Safe.
